



### **Join the fun.....**

Scuba Camp is a great experience for kids aged 10-15 to get introduced to Scuba Diving and the underwater world. During the week we will play games, do activities, have lessons etc. all geared towards making kids aware and comfortable with the water and the ocean. Campers will receive a referral towards their Jr. Open Water Diver certification, which means all they have to do is complete their training dives to get certified!

### **How it works.....**

Camp will start at 8:00 each day. Every day will be broken into two halves—our in water activities and our land based activities, separated by a lunch break. In water activities include learning how to set up a don our gear, basic skills, and games, relay races and underwater activities.

Our land based activities will focus on learning more about scuba diving and the underwater world. Fish identification activities, underwater sign language, games, and other activities, all designed to introduce campers to scuba diving and teach them how be safe, responsible divers will fill our afternoons.

Pick up time will be 5:00 each day.

Camp tuition is \$795, and includes:

- camp fees
- Text book and DVD
- Masks, fins & snorkels
- Dive Log Book
- Use of scuba gear (bc, regulator, wetsuit, tanks, weights)
- 

Campers are responsible for providing:

- transportation
- Lunch (coolers will be available)

\*campers must complete a set of performance requirements, including written quizzes and skills demonstrations, to receive certification

## **Registering For Camp**

## **Preparing for Camp**

Once your registration is processed, you will receive a packet in the mail with several forms to fill out, information on camp, and information on making your full balance payment. This packet needs to be mailed back to us no later than 60 days from the start of your camp. The packet will include:

- 1) A Scuba Camp Agreement\*—lays out campers and parents responsibilities, Atlantic Edge responsibilities, etc.
- 2) A camper information sheet\*— height, weight, age, parent/guardian contact info, etc.
- 3) The PADI Medical Statement\*—This includes a series of Yes/No questions regarding your camper's health history. If any of the questions are answered 'Yes', a Doctor's signature is required indicating the camper can dive.
- 4) PADI Liability Release\*
- 5) PADI Safe Diving Practices Release\*
- 6) Balance Payment Information

### *Class Materials*

Once we have received your camp packet back, we will send your camper their Class Materials, including PADI Open Water Text Book & DVD.

Campers are responsible for reading the book ( 5 chapters ), watching the DVD and answering the 5 short 'Knowledge Reviews' at the end of each chapter, prior to coming to camp.

Included in the class materials package will be the 'PADI Youth in Diving' statement, which parents and campers will fill out together and bring to the first day of camp, after having viewed the 'Youth in Diving' section on the DVD.

## **Scuba Camp FAQ's**

**Q: What is Scuba Camp?**

A: Scuba Camp is a 5 day experience for children ages 10-15 to experience scuba diving and learn about the ocean and the underwater world. They are taught at a pace geared towards the way kids learn with lots of games and activities instead of lessons and lectures.

**Q: When is Scuba Camp?**

A: There are several dates for Scuba Camp this Please visit the Scuba Camp page on our website ( [www.atlanticedge.com](http://www.atlanticedge.com) ) for the entire schedule including dates and locations.

**Q: What does Scuba Camp Cost?**

A: Scuba Camp costs \$795 and includes camp tuition, students text book and video and use of all gear.

**Q: What gear do I need to provide?**

A: Atlantic Edge will lend campers all the gear they need, including BC's, regulators, tanks, weights, and wetsuits, masks, fins snorkels. Students will also bring lunches to camp each day, coolers will be provided to keep food cold.

**Q: What must campers do to prepare?**

A: In order to prepare for camp, campers will need to watch the DVD and read the text book that will be provided to them. The material is about scuba diving, scuba diving safety, and general scuba diving info. In the text book, there are 5 chapters, at the end of each is a 'Knowledge Reivew' - short quiz—that campers will also need to fill out prior to the start of camp.

In addition, campers and parents will need to fill out and return the Camp Information Packet, which will be sent out upon registration.

**Q: Do Campers Get Scuba Certified?**

A: Campers who meet the minimum requirements will be given a 'referral', which means they have completed their class work and pool work towards their Scuba Certification. All campers will have to do after that is their four training dives. Dives can be done with Atlantic Edge in two days, either at our local lake in Pennsylvania or on one of our trips to Fort Lauderdale. Alternatively campers can take their referrals on your next vacation and complete their dives with any instructor in the world.
