In order to make your training experience the best it can possibly be, read this document carefully. Scuba Review courses take place during ½ day at the Quince Orchard Swim & Tennis Club. The session will be split between a classroom knowledge review session and an inwater review session. If your class is on Saturday it will be Saturday afternoon. If your class is on Sunday, it will be Sunday morning. Please refer to the online schedule for the day of your specific class.

** Note – A Scuba Review course is meant to refresh scuba diving skills, not to reteach them. If you have been out of diving for an extended period of time, please contact us to make sure that the level of instruction in a Scuba Review course will be appropriate for you.

Preparation

Before you arrive to your first class, there are two things you must have- completed paperwork and the proper gear. Details on each are below.

Paperwork

In order to facilitate the progress of class, it is imperative that all students have their paperwork complete. Below is a list of necessary items and where these items can be obtained:

Please have these items with you and completely filled out when you come to your first class. Please go over the medical statement as early as possible- there are medical related questions, if you answer 'yes' to any of them you will need a doctor to sign off that you are OK to dive.

Gear

Atlantic Edge will provide you with all necessary gear except mask, fins, and snorkel (and booties, if necessary). You must have these items prior to the beginning of your class. Atlantic Edge offers a wide array of choices in all of these items, and our staff would be happy to help you find the appropriate gear for you.

Checklist

- Mask, Fins and Snorkel
- Your Certification Card
- PADI Medical Statement
- PADI Liability Release
- PADI Safe Diving Practices Release

- All documents and knowledge reviews must be completed and you must bring them to your first class. If you don't have your documentation and knowledge reviews, you will be rescheduled into the next class and subject to the rescheduling fee.
