Preparation

Before you arrive to your first class, there are three things you must have- completed paperwork, completed knowledge reviews, and your gear. Details on each are below.

Paperwork

Gear

Atlantic Edge Dive Center will provide you with tanks and weights for your training dives. You are responsible for all other gear including mask, fins, snorkel, wetsuit, BC's and regulators. If you do not have this gear, one of our staff members would be happy to help you select a mask, fins, and snorkel for purchase and/or size you up for a BC, regulator and wetsuit to rent.
