

MILLBROOK LAKE INFORMATION SHEET

Hours of Operation:

Hours of operation may change in early spring and late fall.

Saturdays: 8am-6pm. No entry allowed into the quarry after 4pm and no diving after 4:30 PM for those departing by 6pm. Gates reopen after night dive from 9:30 PM -10:30 PM. Over night camping begins Memorial weekend and ends Labor Day weekend. \$6.00 per person and next day's pass will be collected by manager that evening.

Sundays: 8am-5pm, no admittance after 3pm. Do not enter the water after 3:30pm.

Admission:

Millbrook Quarry is a private facility available to certified divers, snorkelers and guests only. Scuba certification is required. Proof of certification may be requested at the gate. Students in training will need to identify their instructor by name.

Tickets/waivers are required for all persons over 5 years of age. Day tickets/waivers are available for \$18 at Atlantic Edge. **TICKETS COST \$30 AT THE GATE.** Tickets/waivers are valid for entry during the season purchased, which ends around Thanksgiving. Unused tickets/waivers may not be returned or exchanged for the next season's tickets.

Instructors- you must have on file at The Dive Shop the necessary paperwork from Atlantic Edge with proof of liability insurance and certification status. Stop at the trailer; present your current instructor pass and list of your students. Let the manager know where you want your students directed.

Directions:

- From Atlantic Edge, take route 270 south to 495 towards northern Virginia.
- Take route 66 west to exit 40 (Leesburg/Haymarket), route 15.
- Take route 15 south, left at stop sign.
 - At the first light, make a right onto route 55.
 - Follow route 55 for 3.6 miles. Look for small bridge marked "Broad Run Bridge".
 - After crossing the bridge, take a left onto the dirt road marked by a 55-gallon drum painted like a dive flag.
 - You missed the entrance if you pass route 600 and a post office on your left.

Rules of Millbrook Quarry:

1. Stop at the gate and present your quarry ticket and your certification card.
2. Speed limit is 15 miles per hour.
3. All water activities must be done with a partner.
4. All scuba divers must wear a buoyancy compensator (BC) and a submersible Pressure gauge (SPG).
5. No pets.
6. No jumping off cliffs.
7. Gate closes promptly at 6pm.
8. No air compressors allowed for refilling of tanks
9. Fires: bring your own wood, use fire rings, extinguish fires completely.
