Join the Fun

Scuba Camp is a great experience for kids ages 10 to 15 to get introduced to Scuba Diving and the Underwater World. During the week we play games, do activities, have lessons, etc. all geared towards making kids aware of and comfortable with the water and scuba equipment. Campers 10 and older will receive a referral towards their Jr. Open Water Diver certification, which means all they have to do is complete their training dives to get certified!

How It Works

Camp starts at 8am each day. Every day will be broken into two halves – in-water activities and land based activities, separated by a lunch break. Morning in-water activities include learning how to set up and don our gear, basic skills, games, relay races, and lots of underwater fun!

Our afternoon land based activities will focus on learning more about scuba diving and the underwater world. Land based activities include fish identification, underwater sign language, games, and other activities, all designed to introduce campers to scuba diving and teach them how to be safe, responsible divers.

Drop off time is 8am each day. Camp ends at 3pm each day, but we have a flexible pick-up time of anytime between 3pm and 4pm each day. We will continue extra activities and have play time between 3pm and 4pm. Campers must be able to swim for 200 yards and tread water for 10 minutes.

Scuba Camp costs cover:

- Pool Fees
- Use of Masks, Fins & Snorkels
- Use of Scuba Gear (BC, Regulator, Tanks, Weights, Wetsuit)
- All materials (eLearning online)

Campers are responsible for providing:

- Transportation
- Lunch (coolers will be provided)
